Is solar power a good investment in New Zealand?

The investment is worthwhile for New Zealanders living in areas where power is costly or for those who wish to live off-grid solar and enjoy energy independence and the safety it affords. Calculating the payback period depends on how much your solar power system generates or "generated power" against current electricity prices.

How many solar panels do I need in New Zealand?

Figuring out how many solar panels you need for your home in New Zealand doesn't have to be a head-scratcher. It all comes down to your household's energy habits, roof space, and how much sunshine your area gets. Most Kiwi homes opt for systems between 4kW and 8kW, which translates to around 9 to 19 solar panels.

What types of solar panels are available in NZ?

Polycrystalline solar panel Polycrystalline solar panels are probably the most common type of NZ solar power panels. They are also the cheapest type of solar panel to make and therefore have one of the lowest revenue per kWh numbers in front of them. The positive side is that their low cost makes them very popular solar panels.

Why do New Zealand homes use solar power without a power storage system?

Homes that are grid-connected without a power storage system are prevalent in the New Zealand solar industry. These households use electricity from the main grid when there is a shortage of sunlight to generate energy and rely on solar power during cloudy days or at night time. The verdict
